WHAT WE NEED IF YOU ARE SUPPLYING YOUR OWN ADVERT...

Fully Produced Adverts

Finished adverts are better supplied in a compressed format, using the following specs:

> Quicktime container format (.mov or .mp4), H.264 compression, 1998 x 1080 (or 1920 x

1080), 24fps

> Audio stereo mix, AAC, 48KHz

WHAT WE NEED IF WE ARE PRODUCING YOUR ADVERT...

Video > HD Video Size: 1920 x 1080 or 1998 x 1080 (not 720)

> Frame rate 24 or 25fps> Field progressive

> Aspect ratio 16:9 (1.78:1). 4:3 aspect ratios will not be accepted

> Quicktime container format (.mov or .mp4)

> H.264

NOTE: If raw video footage is supplied, please only send the essential clips.

Audio > Separate stems (files) of voice over, music and sound effects.

> 2 channel stereo audio as WAV or AIFF at 48KHz, 24bit

Images > Digital photos in jpeg, tiff, psd, or png format

> Images below 10 megapixel (most smart phone photos) will not be accepted

> Illustrations in eps, pdf, or high-res, png format

> Images to be sent through as high resolution as possible (ideally 300dpi), 1MB file size will

usually suffice
